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SEWER GROUP 714

La Jolla

Background

Sewer Group 714 is part of the City of San Diego's continuing annual capital improvement program that replaces old, deteriorated sewer mains within the City's right-of-way. The program also consists of relocating inaccessible sewer mains to the streets, which makes the sewer mains more accessible for maintenance purposes. The sewer mains to be replaced by this project have completed their useful life and replacement is necessary in order to decrease sewer main stoppages and improve the sewage collection systems.

Project Overview

Sewer Group 714 will replace and/or install approximately 6,655 linear feet of 8-inch and 10-inch sewer main. The project includes the connection of existing sewer lateral services to the newly installed sewer mains, curb ramp installation and street resurfacing. The project is currently at the 100% design phase.

The limits of construction activities for Sewer Group 714 are concentrated within the following streets: Bonair Way to the north, Midway Street to the south, Dolphin Place to the west and Bellevue Avenue to the east (refer to the location map on the reverse side).

Construction Schedule and Cost

Construction is scheduled to start in September 2011 and is estimated to complete in May 2012.

Traffic control will be provided to continue traffic flow throughout construction. The contractor will also be directed at all times to keep the area as clean as possible from dirt and dust.

Cost of Construction: approximately \$1.4 million.
